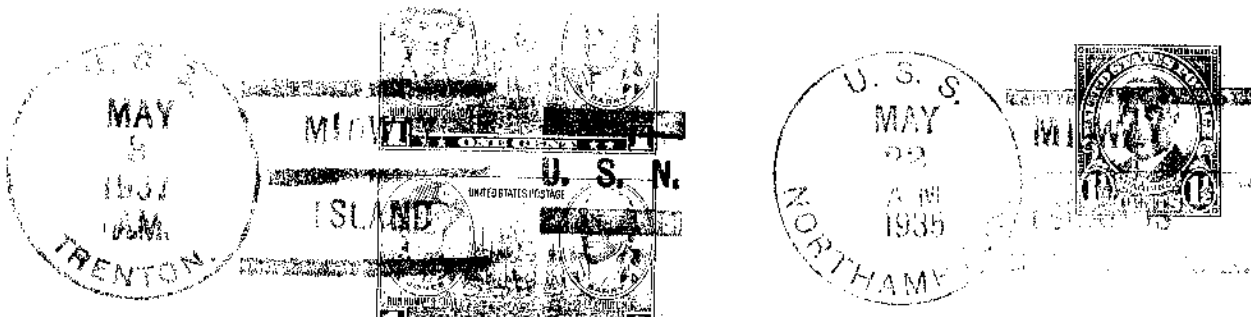
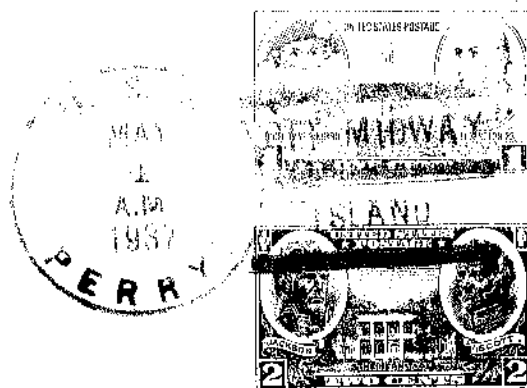
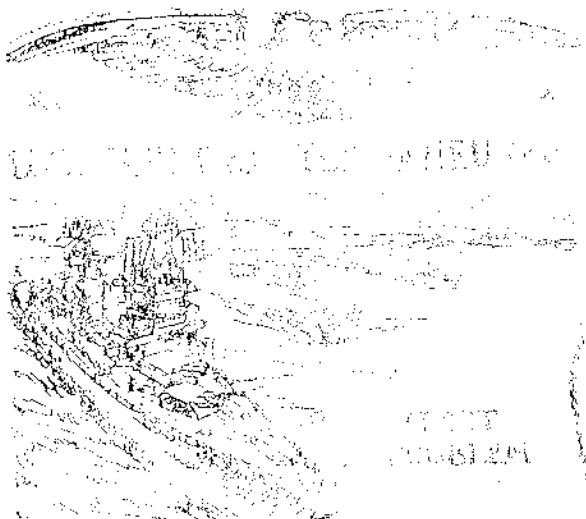


MIDWAY ISLAND IN NAVAL SHIP CANCELS

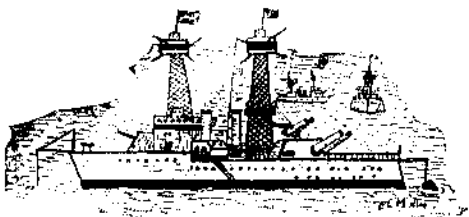

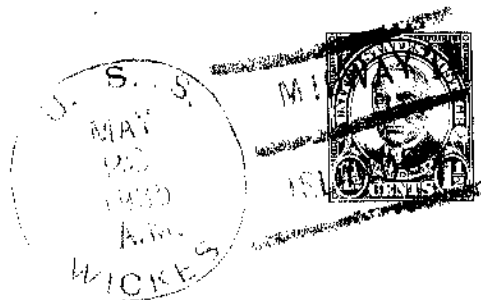
