Meter Machines:

On Page 2 of Bulletin Number 3 reference was made to an indistinct meter number PB 3570327 or PB 3370327 currently in use at the Post Office. This is now confirmed as PB 3370327 still in use on Feb 8 1994. Also in use at Kwajalein Post Office on Feb 8 1994 was Meter Number PB 3352801 with the datehead reading "APO SAN FRANCISCO/96555" Unfortunately neither of these will reproduce clearly.

THE HANDSTAMPS AND ISSUE DATES OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS POSTAL SERVICE. An 8 page study of the handstamps and issue dates during the Transition Period, May 2 1984 to May 1 1985. 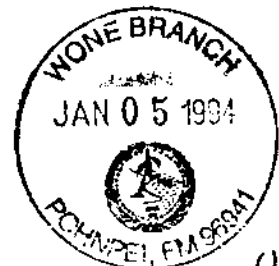
