U.S. NAVY FPO AP 96540: CORRECTION; Bulletin # 13, Page 4 - Fifth item down - Line 6. For FPO AP 96950 read FPO AP 96540.

GUAM M.P.O.: Thanks to Gabe Pustel for **Illustration 14/28**. This is Murphy 1.2 - the 4-Bar showing Guam erroneously as part of the Trust Territory and reported by Murphy to have been used briefly in 1979. At first it was believed to have been corrected by the removal of "TT" but in Addenda No. 1 of "A Postal History/Cancellation Study of the U.S. Pacific Islands" by Robert T. Murphy it [for an identical datestamp] was reported to have been used again on Oct. 24, 1983. In **Illustration 14/28** it appears, dated Oct 29, 1983, apparently overstepping an Agana meter mark [# PB 1297736] on a commercial cover from Alpha Insurers.

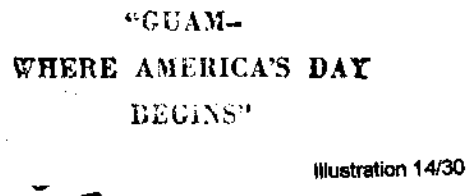
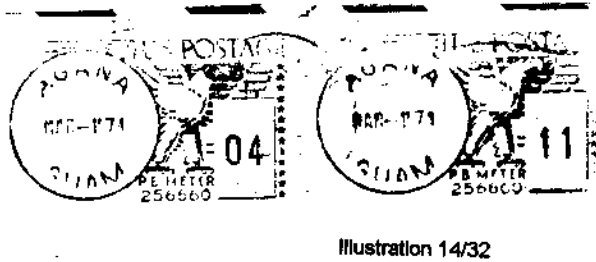
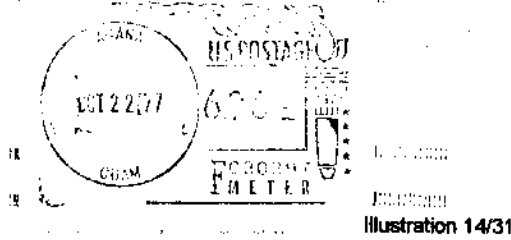



AGANA - METER MARKS: Gabe Pustel has sent details of a number of Meters some not listed and some which extend the dates of use shown in "A Postal History/Cancellation Study of the U.S. Pacific Islands" by Robert T. Murphy.

PB 509680 shown by Murphy as Type 5.4 - "User Unknown" used in May 1970. Gabe sends 2 covers bearing this meter. The first dated Oct 14 '66 is shown as **Illustration 14/29** the second dated May 15 '70 is shown as **Illustration 14/30**. Gabe also sends **Illustration 14/31** which shows Friden Meter F 030397 dated Oct 22,77. This meter is listed by Murphy as Type 5.11- in use at Naval Air Station Post Office between July 25, 1972 to March 20, 1978.

PB 243237 is shown by Murphy as Type 5.3 - used by AFIA Worldwide Insurance Co. between January 3, 1974 and November 5, 1975. The date of use can now be extended to Nov. 14, 1975.

PB256660 is another Murphy Type 5.3 - but unlisted by Murphy. The example send by Gabe is dated Mar 1 '74. The return address on the envelope shows the user to be Perez Bros., Inc. [See **Illustration 14/32**]

METERS: Gabe Pustel send amendments to a couple of Saipan meters listed in Murphy.

PB 1342843 shown in "A Postal History/Cancellation Study of the U.S. Pacific Islands" by Robert T. Murphy as in use April 6, 1978 to March 27, 1981 by J.C. Tenorio Enterprises was still in use on Jan 13, 1982 with the slogan "OETEN/CENTER/SAIPAN"

PB 1277186 shown in Murphy as issued to Mike White on July 16, 1976 was used on Aug 14, 1981 on an envelope bearing two return addresses e.g. J.C. Tenorio Enterprises Inc., Saipan and ?? Novo-Gradac, Capitol Hill.
